

Low Impact Development & Riparian Land Use Changes Workshop

Thursday March 1, 2012 from 8:30 AM – 12:30 PM



This half-day program will present ways to incorporate development practices that are sensitive to aquatic resources, minimize impact to the land, and appropriately address stormwater treatment. In light of climate change preparedness, the program will also focus on infrastructure adaptations, low impact development (LID) techniques, and habitat conservation measures that respond to water inundation and projected changes in the timing and volume of precipitation. Considering the link between land use to water quality, the program will also explore the changes in land use along waterways and review the impacts differing land uses can have on water resources.
